Student Exchange Agreement

The École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts de Paris, France (E.N.S.BA.) and the Faculty of Fine Arts of Baroda- Maharaja Sayajirao University, desire to enhance their educative processes and increase the mutual understanding of their students in the advancement and dissemination of learning hereby establish a student exchange program.

The Ecole is overseen by the French Ministry of Culture and Communication. Its first mission is to educate and train students planning to devote themselves to high-level artistic creation.

To that end both parties agree as follows:

1. In any one year during the term of the agreement, no more than two students from each university may be enrolled as full-time non-degree students at the other University for a period of one semester (4 months). Students participating in this program will continue as degree candidates in their home university.

2. The program is open to graduate students, and to undergraduate students who have completed at least three years of undergraduate study. Participating students will be selected by the home university generally on the basis of academic merit. It is understood that the host university reserves the right to reject any candidate in which case the home university may nominate additional candidates for consideration.

3. Each participating student will take courses regularly offered at the host university and will enjoy the same rights and privileges and be subject to the same regulations and discipline as students at that university. The universities will provide each other with adequate information on the performance of participating students and each university will nominate a member of staff to coordinate the program.

4. The universities agree that any incidental fees assessed against participating students under this agreement shall not be greater than those normally paid by students of the host university. Neither university shall make any charge for tuition, application or administrative purposes under this agreement. Participating students must have medical insurance and legal liability.

5. The universities agree that if residence hall or other suitable accommodation is available, it will be at a cost no greater than that normally charged to the host university's students. The payment of such housing together with the payment for all travel, medical insurance, legal liability and subsistence costs shall be the responsibility of the individual students participating in the program and neither university shall be held liable for such charges. Students selected as exchange students, must provide the host University with an attestation of their coverage. Students selected shall also satisfy the host university that they have adequate funds for transportation to and from the host university and for subsistence during their enrollment at the host university.

6. The agreement will commence from the date this Student Exchange Agreement is signed by both parties and continue thereafter for five (5) years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Either university may, by notice in writing of no less than six months terminate this agreement, but any students who have commenced at either university at the date of termination may complete their course of study. The universities will confer concerning the renewal of this agreement six months prior to its expiration.
7. This Student Exchange Agreement will not violate/over-ride the existing statutes, ordinances, guidelines and established code of conduct of both the Parties.


